


PIKE ST TO BE ONE-WAY EASTBOUND BETWEEN 1ST AND BELLEVUE AVENUES

As early as Saturday, November 18, we will permanently remove westbound vehicle access on Pike St between Bellevue Ave and Terry Ave / Hubbell Pl to make Pike St a one-way, eastbound street. By switching to one-way streets east of 9th Ave now, we will make more space for ongoing construction of new sidewalks, curbs, markings, and traffic signals and ultimately, a safer and more pleasant experience for all users. Westbound bike travel on Pike St will remain during construction until further notice.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON PIKE ST BRIDGE OVER AND EAST OF I-5

PEDESTRIAN, BICYCLIST AND VEHICLE ACCESS:

- Westbound vehicle access on Pike St between Bellevue Ave and Terry Ave / Hubbell Pl will be permanently removed, Pike St between 1st and Bellevue avenues will be one-way eastbound for vehicle traffic
- Westbound bike travel will remain during construction until improved routing is established
- Detours may be used for all modes of travel; follow signs, signals and directions from officers for safe access through the area
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Access for businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
- Bicyclists may be routed differently on the same street or detoured at times while improvements to the bicycle lane are constructed
- Bus stop and route impacts will be shared by King County Metro, check out their service advisories for more information

WORK ZONE:

Pike St between 9th and Bellevue avenues

SCHEDULE AND HOURS:

- Work hours typically Monday through Friday,
 7 AM to 5 PM
- Any necessary overnight and weekend work will be communicated in advance

PARKING AND LOAD ZONES:

- Parking restrictions will be in place, as needed; signs will be present
- Load zones may be temporary relocated as needed
- Access to garages and alleys on Pike St will be maintained

EQUIPMENT AND NOISE:

- Expect construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work zone
- Construction trucks and equipment may be noisy, with the most significant noise coming from breaking and removing roadway pavement
