

CONSTRUCTION WORK ON COLUMBIA STREET STARTING EARLY AUGUST

With the viaduct ramp now gone, Waterfront Seattle construction will start on Columbia Street as early as Monday, August 5. We are transforming Columbia Street into a two-way corridor with transit lanes and improved sidewalks. Other activities include installation of new underground utilities. Work is expected to last approximately four months.

WORK ZONES

- Columbia Street between Alaskan Way and 1st Avenue (see map)
- East side of Western Avenue between Marion Street and north of Yesler Way for material storage

SCHEDULE AND HOURS

- Monday through Friday, 7 AM to 5 PM
- Occasional overnight and weekend work

PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE ACCESS

- Columbia Street will be closed to vehicles at First Avenue
- East side of Western Avenue between Marion Street and north of Yesler Way will be closed; two-way traffic will be maintained and flaggers may be present to direct vehicles
- Post Avenue will be closed intermittently, follow signs for garage access
- First Avenue travel lanes will be reduced intermittently
- Sidewalk may be closed on one side
- Access will remain available for businesses and residences

PARKING AND LOAD ZONES

• On-street parking and loading temporarily restricted

EQUIPMENT AND NOISE

 Construction trucks and equipment may be noisy; the most significant noise coming from breaking and removing roadway pavement and from vacuum trucks locating utilities

OTHER AREA PROJECTS

 Later this fall, we will start work to rebuild Alaskan Way following viaduct demolition; sign up for our email updates to stay informed
