



WATERFRONT RESTROOM CONSTRUCTION STARTING IN LATE JUNE

Located in the Promenade and near Pier 58

Construction of the all-gender public restroom, located on the Park Promenade between Union and University streets, will begin as early as Monday, June 24. Expect the work zone to narrow the space for people walking during work hours. Work on the restroom will take approximately 6 months to complete.

WORK ZONE:

- In the Promenade adjacent to Pier 58.

HOURS & DURATION:

- Beginning as early as Monday, June 24, work is anticipated to take approximately 6 months.
- Work hours typically Monday through Friday, 7 AM to 5 PM
- Weekend and night work as needed; details will be communicated in advance

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian path narrowed during work hours.
- Parking near the work site may be prohibited for staging or equipment and materials to support construction.

ACTIVITIES:

- Expect construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of work zone.
- Construction trucks and equipment may be noisy, with the most significant noise coming from steel erection, welding and connections.

The restroom includes six individual all-gender stalls including an accessible stall. The City convened focus groups to hear from community members with different lived experiences to identify and prioritize restroom features and inform the overall design. Key goals for the restroom are making it a welcoming, safe, and clean facility for users of all ages and abilities, accommodating families, and expressing the unique character of Waterfront Park.
