




TRAFFIC SHIFT TO NEW LANES ON EAST SIDE OF ALASKAN WAY

Overnight on Monday, July 18 from 7 PM until 6 AM on Tuesday, July 19, Alaskan Way will be reduced to one lane each direction between Columbia and Pike streets to move traffic onto five blocks of new roadway! The “S”-like curves currently between Marion and Madison streets will be relocated north between Union and Pike streets.

With a large portion of the new roadway completed, we begin work to construct the park promenade. Following the traffic shift, the new configuration of Alaskan Way will have two lanes in each direction south of Union St and one lane each direction north of Union St.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON ALASKAN WAY:

Overnight on Monday, July 18

- Overnight work from 7 PM on Monday, July 18 to 6 AM on Tuesday, July 19
- One lane each direction on Alaskan Way between Columbia and Pike streets, temporarily as we work to complete the traffic shift
- Alaskan Way closed between Pike and Pine streets from 9 PM to 6 AM for Aquarium Expansion construction, vehicles will be redirected to Western Ave between University and Wall streets
- Traffic signal outages – watch for signals in red flashing mode and uniformed officers directing traffic



Opening July 19 north of Marion St:

- Two lanes in each direction south of Union St
- One lane in each direction north of Union St
- Local access road southbound only between Seneca and Union streets
- New wider sidewalks on east side of Alaskan Way
- Landscaped areas
