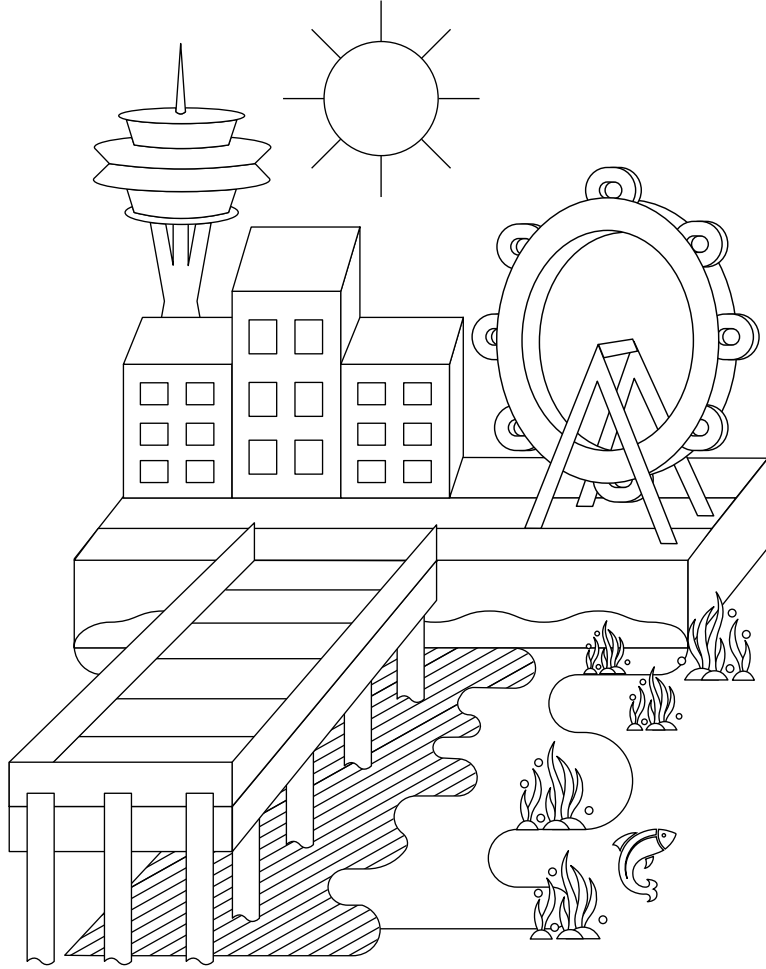
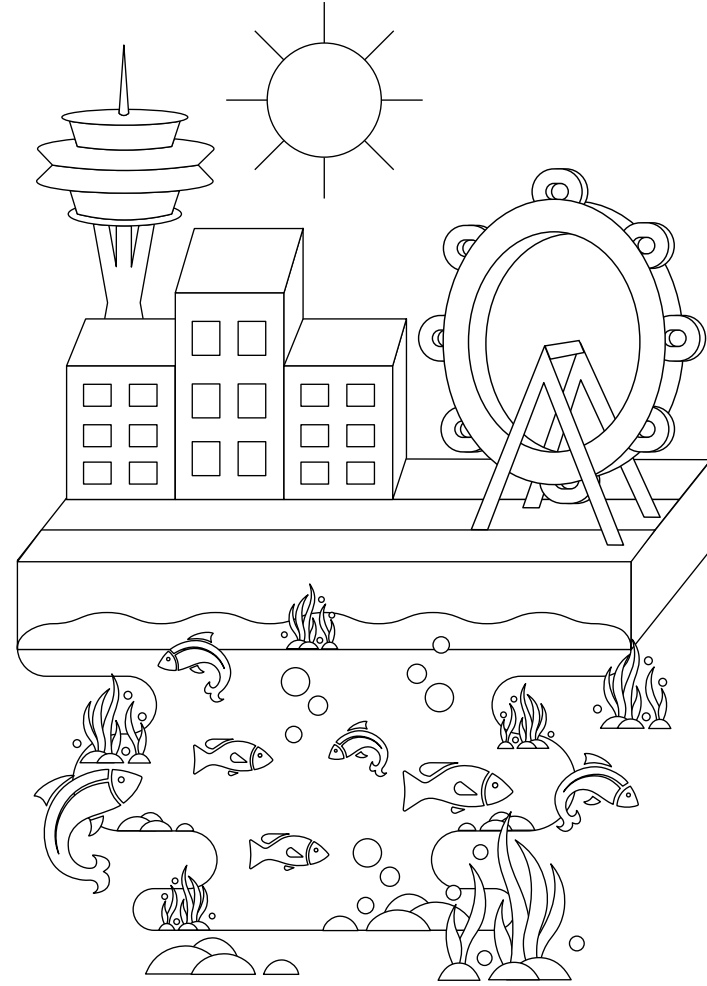


Here is a coloring page showing before/after Pier 63 was removed and nearby habitat improvements were made. Can you spot the differences?

Answer key:
1. More rocks at the bottom of the water, which makes the area shallower and lets light get to the bottom more easily. The material is designed for plant growth, which attracts smaller marine life, that salmon eat. **2. No shadow being cast by the pier,** allowing light through to support plant growth. **3. More aquatic plants.** More light equals more plants! **4. More fish.** More aquatic plants equals more fish!
