


PIONEER SQUARE EAST-WEST STREETS








- We began work on S Main

 like landscaping.




S MAIN ST BETWEEN ALASKAN WAY S & 1ST AVE S (FEBRUARY 2024)






S MAIN ST BETWEEN ALASKAN WAY S & 1ST AVE S (MARCH 2024)











YESLER WAY PLAN








KING STREET – PRESENT DAY





KING STREET PLAN










UPCOMING WORK ZONE



- We expect to begin on Yesler
 Way as early as April 22.
- Work should take about 3 months.
- Vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
- Yesler Way between Alaskan
 Way S and 1st Ave S may be
 reduced to alternating two-way
 traffic during off-peak hours.




Map of new work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Work hours typically Monday through Friday, 7 AM to 5 PM
- Pedestrian access and access to residences & businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Alleys will be accessible from one end at all times for both vehicle and pedestrian access.
- Bike lanes may be temporarily relocated, access will be maintained.
- Commercial loading zones may be relocated temporarily.




Map of new work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Early construction activities will include potholing and pavement breaking which may cause increased noise and vibration.
- Work includes expanding the sidewalk areas, installing landscaping and minor repaving of the roadway
- Expect construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work zone
