

S Washington St between Alaskan Way S and 1st Ave S will permanently change to become a single-lane, westbound-only street in an upcoming traffic revision happening as early as December 11. In conjunction, Alaskan Way traffic will shift to the east, between S King and Columbia streets, and S Washington St will be reconnected to northbound Alaskan Way S. Construction on Alaskan Way will continue on the west side of the road between S King and Columbia streets.

The traffic revision at S Washington St is a part of the future pedestrian improvements to S Main, S Washington and S King streets and Yesler Way as part of the **Pioneer Square East West Pedestrian Improvements** project.



## WHAT TO EXPECT ON S WASHINGTON ST:

### Pedestrian and vehicle access:

- Single-lane, westbound-only from 1st Ave S to Alaskan Way S beginning as early as December 11
- Right turn only onto northbound Alaskan Way S
- Sidewalks open on both sides of street and new sidewalk open on east side of new Alaskan Way S

#### Parking and load zones:

• Parking and loading zones on both sides of S Washington St, accessed westbound only

## WHAT TO EXPECT ON ALASKAN WAY:

- Northbound and southbound lanes shift to east side between S King and Columbia streets
- Construction on the west side between S King and Columbia streets
- Colman Dock access will be maintained
- North of Columbia St construction will remain on the east side of Alaskan Way, in the footprint of the former viaduct
- Signalized pedestrian crossings at Alaskan Way S will be provided at S King and S Jackson streets and Yesler Way
